▶ Background

* Mushroom growth of northeastern Asia economy.

- With rapid growth of Chinese economy in northeastern Asia, Japan, Korea and China commanding big parties of global economy.
- Advent of northeastern economy 3rd-notched following EU, NAFTA at global markets.
- Acceleration, enlargement of economy collaboration in northeastern Asia.

* Drastic enlargement of trade volume in northeastern Asia.

- Continuous growth of trade volume in the region.
- Rapid growth of volume of container quantity transported in the region.

➡ Change of logistics environment in northeastern Asia is already occurred.

1. Asia Logistics Standardization

▶ Necessity

- * Ingression of the era of global standardization.
- * Global standardization - emerging as not issue of choice but subsistence.
- * Global standardization - optimizing tool chosen for market expansion.
- * Enlargement of trade volume, but insufficient labor in Asia.
- * Complication of logistics environment - leading to mechanization, automation.
- * Effectiveness improvement of logistics - packaging, transportation, storage, data/information.
- * Introduction of social demand in global standardization - for safety, health, environmental protection.

➡ Needs of logistics standardization in northeastern Asia are pressing.

▶ New perspective for collaboration :

- * To guarantee easier and functional way of trade system,
- * To handle the advent of advanced logistics system from 1st, 2nd economic blocs,
- * To renew close cooperation in Asia as 3rd economic bloc in world.

▶ Deep impact to economy, trade of each nation directly, indirectly :

- * **Cutting of cost,**
- * **Acceleration of growth of trade volume,**
- * **Strengthening of competitive edge of trade, economy.**

➡ New perspective of logistics collaboration in Asia should be set up immediately.

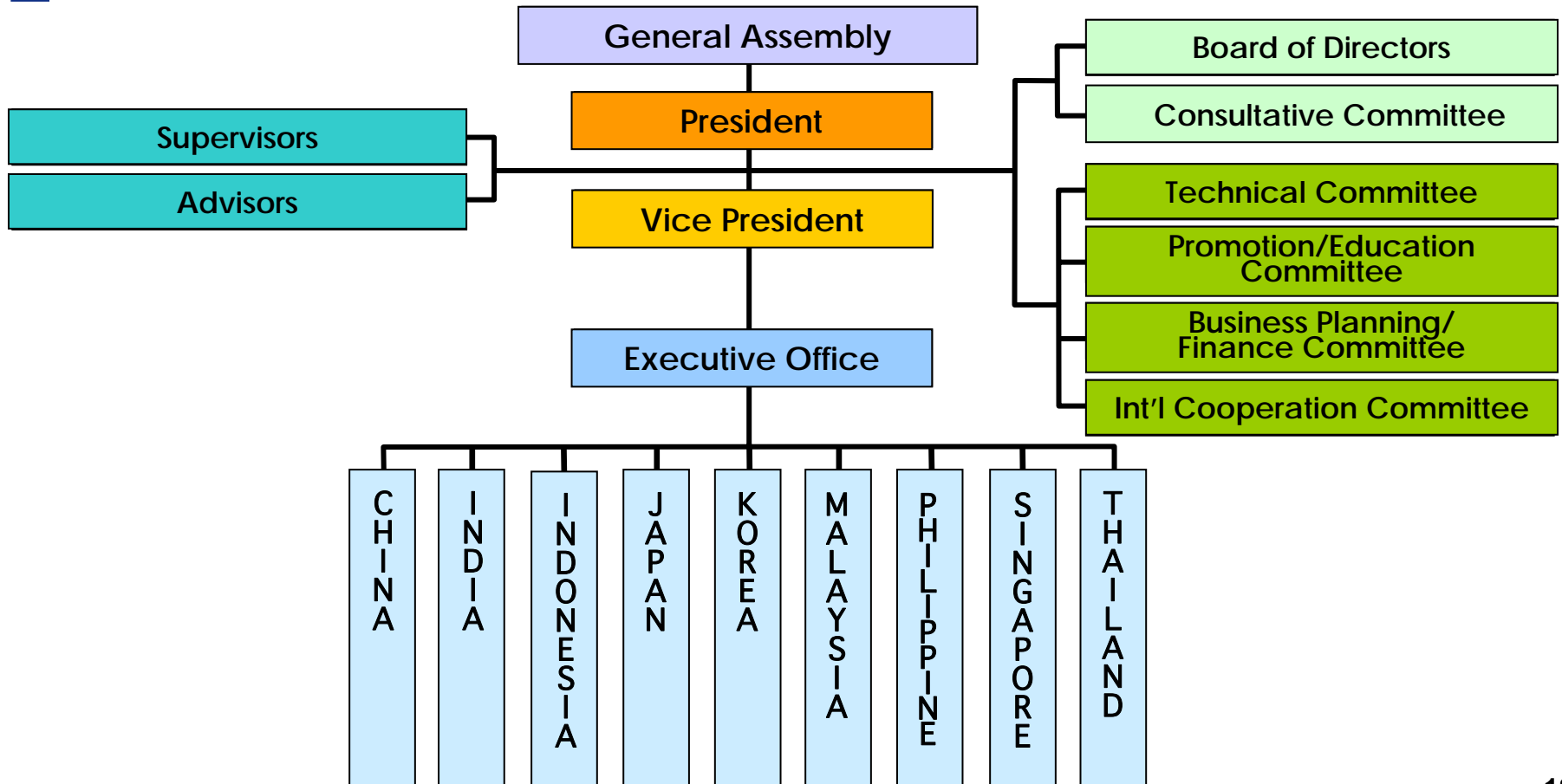
