We share each country's opinion to make global cooperation with CLM, USA, ELA, Europe and the other district of the world in order to build up global logistics network; JILS hope to aggressively exchange opinions with today's participants about the global logistics network project and pursue it. 2). And we need to enhance the activity base of the APLF by exchanging ideas today with the participants on issues such as the promotion of non-member countries' entry and revision to the current member organization's activities. Some member countries do not even attend the APLF general assembly held per two years.(for example, Philippines, Thailand, New Zealand) And JILS is going to effort to build up APLF fund.
